

#### 1. FAST Danube Project

- Environmental Impact Assessment,
  - 2 AA, one for RO (22 Natura 2000) and one for BG (39 Natura 2000), SSCO was considering for elaboration;
  - Only one integrated WFD study;
  - One Climate change study.
- In Bulgaria, the documentation was submitted, to BG MoEW, by 21.08.2023;
- In Romania, the documentation was submitted, to NAEP, by 11.09.2023;



#### 1. FAST Danube Project

- Next steps:
  - October, 2023, public debates in Romania and Bulgaria, 2 weeks;
  - Environmental permits issued in (RO and BG) by December, 2023;
  - Final version of Feasibility Study, December 2023;
  - Application Form, prep. start Sept. 2023, submission Jan. 2024 (CEF II Call).

#### 2. DISMAR Project



- Danube, One river One Integrated Marking System (RO-BG)
  - Integrated Marking Plan;
    - Coastal Marking (lantern for beacons) 2.040 pcs. (1020 pcs/partner);
    - Floating Marking (buoys, lantern and AIS AtoNs) 300 pcs, 160 lanterns + AIS AtoNs;
    - Coastal Marking vessels (RO) and (BG) specialized technical vessel/partner;
  - Integrated Marking Communication Plan, using AIS technology











#### 3. FAIRway Danube II Project



• **Project duration:** 01.04.2023 – 31.12.2027

• Budget: approximately 70 Mil. €

#### Project consortium:

- waterway administrations of Austria, Slovakia, Hungary, Croatia, Romania and Bulgaria,
- the ministries of Austria, Slovakia as associated partners;
- the port authority of Vukovar, as affiliated entity.



#### 3. FAIRway Danube II Project




- Upgrade the existing survey systems;
- Establish fixed and mobile sensors for measuring the key parameters of the Good Navigation Status;
- Upgrade the national (WAMS)/ transnational platform for waterway management (WAMOS);
- Lead-time extension of the water-level forecast, to 7 days;
- Test and validate means to enhance low water resilience through implementation of pilot projects for flexible infrastructure elements in Austria, Croatia, Romania and Bulgaria.




- Daily monitoring the hydrological conditions (water level, discharge from Iron Gates and forecast);
- Weekly, online meetings (RO-BG), for navigations conditions, hydrological conditions and other common actions on the Danube;
- Planning dredging activity in the most critical points:
  - Romania,
    - Calnovat upstream, May 2023 59,000 cm;
    - Bechet, June 2023 91,000 cm;
    - Corabia, July August 2023 52,000 cm (AFDJ vessels);
    - Salcia, August 2023 27,000 cm;
  - Bulgaria,
    - Batin, May 2023 20,000 cm (EAEMDR vessels);
    - Belene, July 2023 67,000 cm;
    - Vardim, August 2023 78,000 cm;





























