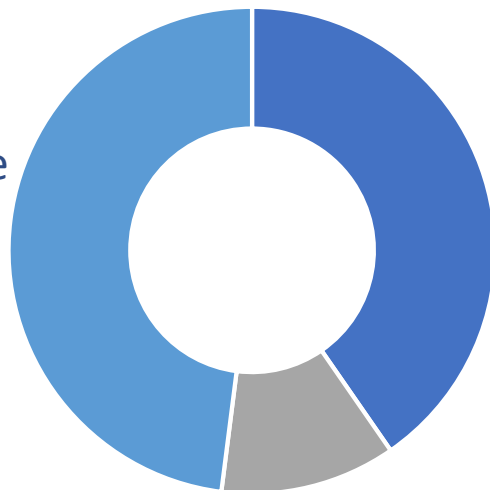

At the initiative of the **President of Ukraine Volodymyr Zelenskyy**, the **#GrainfromUkraine** humanitarian program was launched - the purchase of grain by the developed countries for those that suffer from hunger.


5 vessels with 140 thousand tons of humanitarian wheat from Ukraine have already reached **Kenya, Ethiopia and Somalia**.
Donation made by: **France, Finland, Germany, Japan**.




In addition, **15 vessels** were sent with **465.8 thousand tons** of food, chartered by the **UN World Food Programme (WFP)** to **Ethiopia, Kenya, Afghanistan, Yemen**.

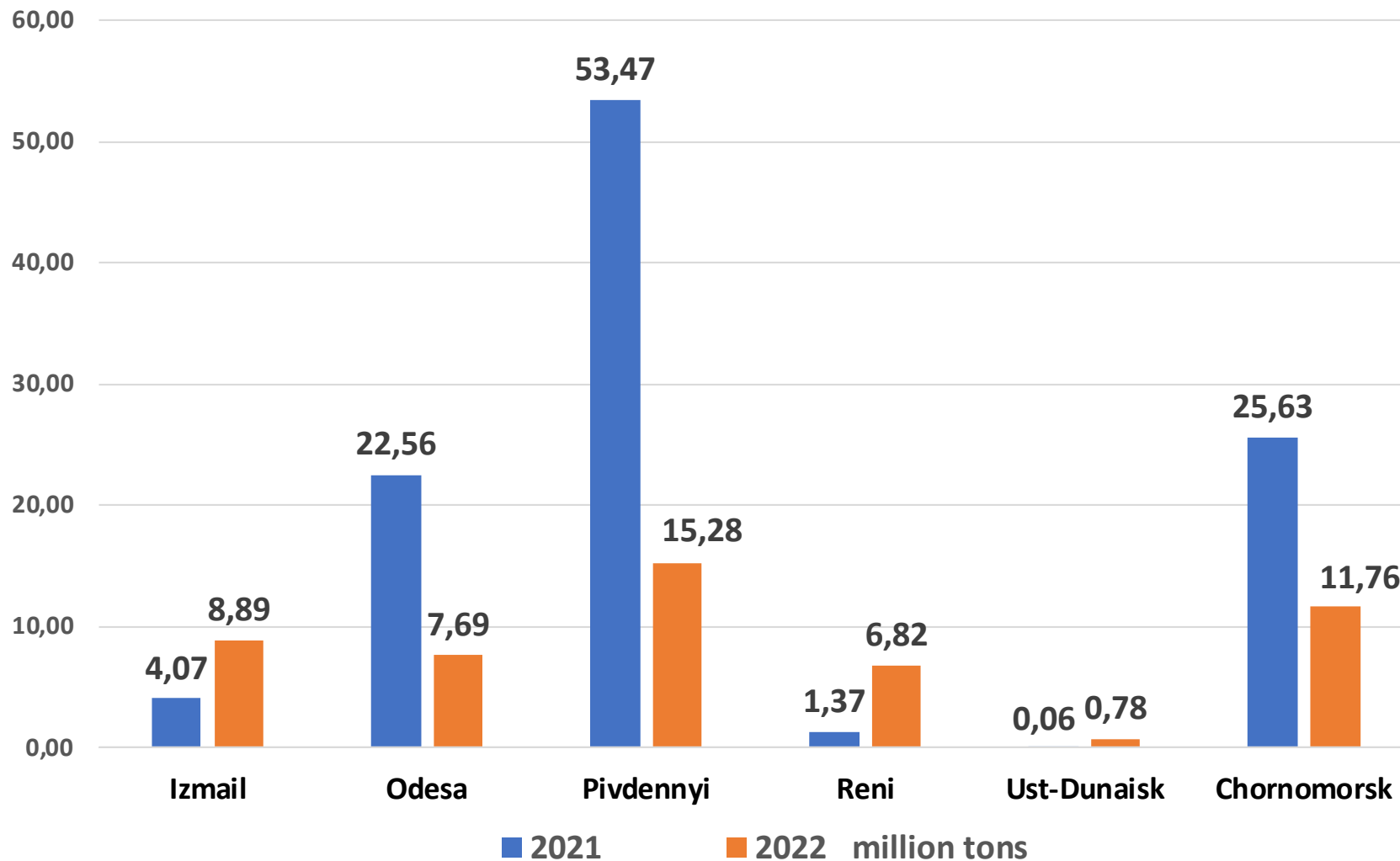
