The Transport Community is an international organisation in the field of mobility and transport with 36 participants – the European Union member states, the six South East European Parties (the Republic of Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo\*, Montenegro, the Republic of North Macedonia, and the Republic of Serbia) and the three observing participants (Georgia, Republic of Moldova and Ukraine)

We are working on integrating Western Balkans' transport markets into the EU by assisting the six Western Balkans partners in adopting and implementing the EU legislation in the transport field and supporting projects connecting Western Balkans regional partners among themselves and with the EU.




