
Timeline of investments in the Debrecen region




MACS Industrial Park area open access Intermodal Container Terminal

- Shunting service between the MACS Industrial Park station and the tracks of the Terminal

Planned data:

- Loading tracks: 7
 - + 4 train receiver and dispatcher track
- Gantry crane (moving on rails): 2
- Truck access gates (OCR)

- Expanding truck storage capacity in cooperation with local forces
- Cross docking (cooperation based)

Schedule of investment



Q1 Ended in May 2023

- Renewal of the Debrecen-Füzesabony railway line 108 between Debrecen and Macs
- A 4-track marshalling yard has been built directly next to the terminal (MÁV area)
- 2 tracks for loading finished cars in the terminal, 1 storage track and 2 crane tracks
- Outside and inside truck parking spaces
- A security fence has been built around the terminal

Estimated completion date: 30 May 2025.

- Electrification of railway line 108


