Objective of the event:

- To promote the use of the Danube waterway and the Danube ports for cargo flows between the Danube region and Türkiye;
- To provide a platform for future targeted cooperation of Danube-IWT stakeholders with Turkish companies with the purpose to facilitate Danube cargo transportation;
- To facilitate successful Danube transport & logistics operations and consequently to create good practices within the community of companies in Hungary and neighbouring countries having cargo flows to and from Türkiye;
- To promote existing and emerging services connecting Danube seaports with seaports in Türkiye;
- To promote new maritime services (Motorways of the Sea) between EU and Türkiye

Rationale:

- The Danube waterway can significantly contribute to improve the environmental performance of the transport system of the Danube region and can offer cost-effective solutions for many industries located in the region;
- There is a significant flow of cargo between the Danube region and Türkiye which predominately uses truck transportation;
- There are insufficient logistics services which connect the Danube region with Türkiye using Danube waterway transportation as well as services of Danube river and seaports;
- There are currently a few projects in the pipeline which are preparing to set up logistics services from Danube seaports to destinations with Türkiye;
- Forthcoming services and business opportunities shall be promoted in the business community of Turkish and Central European entrepreneurs;
